RESOLUTION

3. The role and functions of the Board shall be

- (i) Preparation of Vision, Mission and Long & Short Term Perspective Plan for the State and districts.
- (ii) Collection of primary and secondary data and preparation of sectoral position papers.
- (iii) Review and evaluation of the progress of implementation of the policies and programmes including documentation and dissemination of internal and external best practices and recommendation of such adjustments and measures as the review may indicate for more effective and efficient implementation.
- (iv) Providing knowledge and innovation support to the departments/districts including dissemination of knowledge and innovation through online/offline methods to various stakeholders, specially Govt. and local body functionaries.
- (v) Developing measurable parameters and indices across sectors, in consultation with the departments and also developing a system for inculcating healthy competition across districts by devising a methodology of ranking the districts on these parameters.
- (vi) Convergence and de-duplication among schemes being implemented by different departments.
- (vii) Any other work assigned by the Government.
- (viii) Any other matter incidental or connected to above.

4. Board can draw from top experts/practitioners to be empanelled to support it in undertaking the tasks assigned and can take assistance from officials of the respective Departments. Board would be assisted by an agency to provide real time data, collected from the Departments or otherwise, analysed using latest statistical tools to create different predictive models for guiding different departments.

Ordered that the Resolution be published in the Calcutta Gazette and copies thereof be forwarded to all the Members of the Board and to all Departments, Divisional Commissioners and District Magistrates.
